



# RANGE COMMANDS

Safety is an individual responsibility! If you see an unsafe act = You must STOP it! Anyone can call - Stop-Stop- Stop

RSO:

- 1) Change Flags from Green-to-Red;
- 2) Explain the Command "STOP" (FREEZE, gun on "Safe" wait for further commands);
- 3) The Range Commands you will hear today are:

Range Commands:

Actions executed by shooters

Range going Hot!

1. PPE on – pay attention – listen to the word of command;

This relays with a

\_\_\_\_ round magazine Load!

1. Insert magazine in gun/feed munition into magazines or

breach:

Ready!

1. Chamber a round;

On your own time Fire!

1. Fire at your own time/at your target/to your front;

Stop!

1. Put gun on "Safe" – Stand fast - Wait for further commands;

Unload! For inspection clear Gun!

- 1. Gun on "Safe";
- 2. Remove magazine/munition;
- 3. Open the action/cylinder;
- 4. Inspect the chamber must be empty;
- 5. Close the action and dry-fire-gun down range;
- 6. Re- Open the action (present gun for inspection to RSO)
- 7. Stand fast Wait your turn to be cleared do not move;
- 8. When cleared by RSO dry fire for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time;

Clear!

RSO:

**Physical contact is required** with shooter when "clearing" shooters individually – RSO remain with shooter till entirely

cleared (HG gun back in holster);

Range Clear!

- 1. Shooters move from the Firing Line/ Long-guns: Action open/Muzzle control/place gun in gun rack or sling gun or;
- 2. HG = Holster gun or place gun on table with action/cylinder open;


RSO:

- 1) Change Flags from Red-to-Green;
- 2) Announce: It is now safe to proceed Down-Range.

## Status of a holstered gun - Side-arm & Long-gun - during a Range-Clear (RC)

- No Drawing of a holstered gun during a RC! (Unless at Safe-Table, No munition at the Safe-Table);
- 2. Pistol: Unloaded, slide is forward, hammer down, magazine-well empty; and
- **3.** Revolver: Unloaded, hammer down, cylinder closed, cylinder is empty.







# Range Brief

MPR1/2/3: cal 338 Magnum Lanua – HG1/2/3/4: cal 500 S&W Magnum – Tran: 7 ½ shot or smaller
This Range is templated up-to-and-including (Only state the Range which is going to be used);

### Range Lay-out:

- Down-/Up- Range, (explain Side-Berms vs Backstops, no intentional firing into Side-Berms);
- Range Arc Markers: Left/Right-of-Arc (Yellow Flags) <u>Individual</u> Arcs: Left/Right-edge-of-shooters individual target;
- Explain Flags: Entrance Lease/Range/Firing-Point = Red/Green;
- Static-Firing-Line VS Dynamic Firing-Line VS Dynamic Firing Point (Only explain the one that is going to be used);
- Metal Targets: Min. required safety distance: Long-guns: 50m, Side-Arms: 10m; (Silhouette: cal.22 Long-gun: 10m)
- ➤ 1<sup>st</sup> Aid-Kitt/Fire Extinguishers/Misfire-Cylinder (Point out location);
- Stretcher by the Club House / AED inside the Club House;

#### Actions on:

- ➤ Wildlife Stop Live Fire Let it go by, no harassing of any kind;
- Fire: Structural VS Grass (Explain [your] planned course of action);
- Fire ban: No stoves or charcoal BBQs to be used;
- Evac Route/Muster Point (Explain planned course of action);
- Emergency: Medical/Trng Accident: 1. Call 911/STARS Site # 2102,
   2. Admin 1<sup>st</sup> Aid 3. Send Runner to road, shut down Lease, 4. Secure Lease 5. Call Executive 1-587-315-1549 fill out incident Report);
- 1stAid\_\_\_\_911-caller\_\_\_\_Road-Runner\_\_\_\_Lease-Runner\_\_\_\_; (Introduce personnel [have them step-forward])

## Personal Protective EQPT (PPE):

Eyes & Ears (shooters & spectators);

## Miscellaneous:

- No Marijuana use on the Lease allowed at any time;
- No Alcohol allowed on the Lease (South of the Lease-Gate by Parking-Lot it is allowed to tail-gate);
- Restrooms must be used/not optional;
- Pets/Kids must be under supervision/control at all times;
- Trash: You-bring-it = You-pack-it-out (Including shot-up targets);
- Mobile phones (On vibrate);
- KGAC Consolidated Range Safety & Op's Rules are enforced;
- (If Competition = Explain Comp Rules & Comp Range Commands if no competition = Do not mention it);

### Re-Test Shooters/Ask Questions:

Re-test by asking shooters random questions from the Briefing to verbally reconfirming some of the received Range Briefing points;

If an incident occurs: 1) 911 = admin 1<sup>st</sup> Aid 2) Call Executive 1-587-315-1549 3) Fill out incident rprt 4) Don't make any statements to 3<sup>rd</sup> parties – only designated Executives issues statements
